SEMINAR SCHEDULE

Friday, November 1st will feature another optional bus tour of Forbes Road. This year's tour will leave Jumonville Friday morning at 7:30 am and proceed to Fort Ligonier. The tour will include continental breakfast before we leave and a box lunch during the bus tour. An optional dinner will be available at Jumonville but reservations are required with your registration. The cost for this year's bus tour is \$125/ person and includes all admission fees. Space is limited so sign up now. After the optional Jumonville dinner, we will have our normal 7:00 pm reception in Wesley Hall offering light refreshments, the first look at vendor displays, and a short program at 8:00 pm.
