SEMINAR SCHEDULE

After careful consideration in view of ongoing COVID concerns, the BRPA board has decided to host a hybrid seminar for 2021. The information below contains our current plans for how this year's seminar will be conducted:

Friday - Nov. 5, 2021 - FREE

An optional afternoon **in-person** program is available for Friday. There will be no cost to attend the Friday program but we are requesting that you complete an online registration so that we can properly plan for the program. The program will take place at Fort Necessity and will begin at 1:00 pm and will go through mid-late Friday afternoon. There will be elements of the program that will take place inside the Fort Necessity facilities (including a special look at some of the artifacts) and also several different segments that will take place outside at Fort Necessity. Prepare/dress to be outside for a segment of the afternoon. Also current guidelines will require participants to wear a mask while they are inside the Fort Necessity facility.

Saturday - Nov. 6, 2021 - \$50

Saturday's program will be **online only** and will be conducted out of the facilities at Fort Ligonier. It will be similar to last year's program where many of the programs will be pre-recorded and will be available by a zoom link. There will also be a panel discussion with many of the speakers and also BRPA President, Dr. Walter Powell. We are planning to begin our program at 9:00 am on Saturday morning and estimate that the program will conclude around 4:30 pm.
